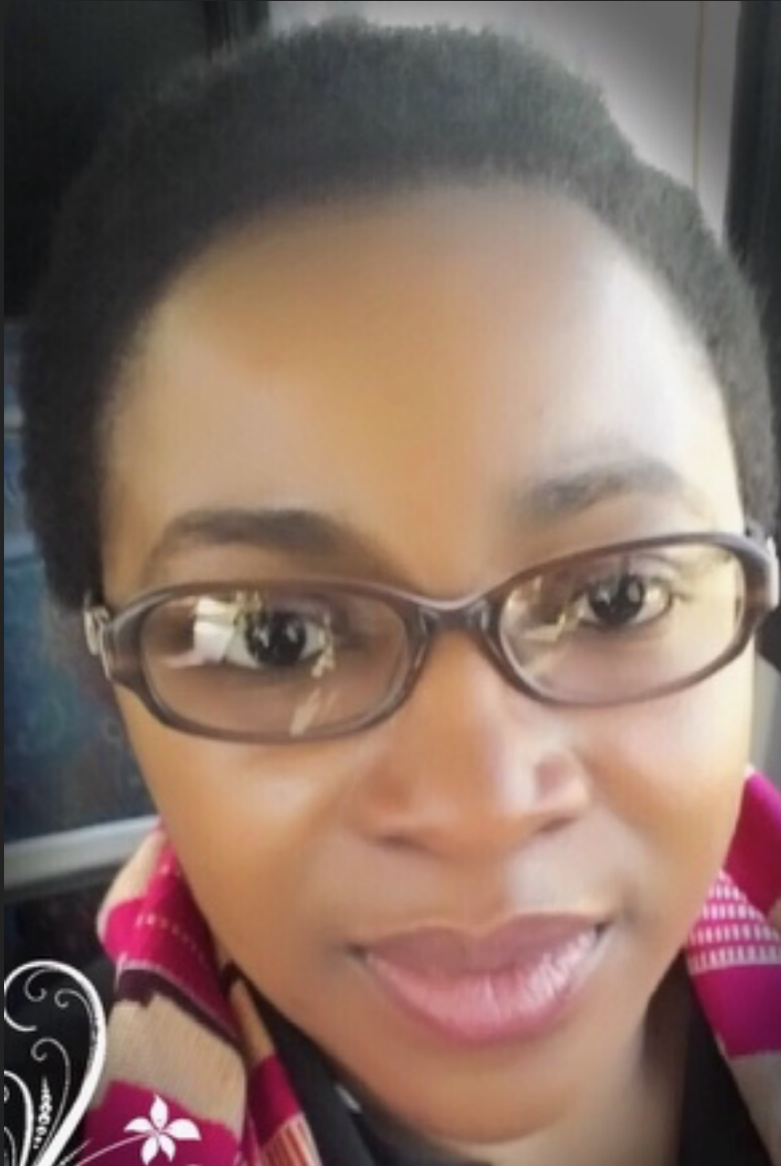


CLAUDIA ALVAREZ
